- 1. To assist the Chief Research Officer in conceptualizing, planning, implementing, and monitoring Dzongkha research works.
- 2. To assist the Chief Research Officer in conceptualizing, planning, implementing, and monitoring research works on indigenous languages of Bhutan.
- 3. To coordinate and provide professional guidance on the research on spoken Dzongkha in different Dzongkha-speaking regions.
- 4. To carry out and supervise research on naturally written Dzongkha by collecting corpus from different institutions and individual writers; carry out grammatical and vocabulary analysis.
- 5. To coordinate and monitor on Natural Language Processing (NLP) related works.
- 6. To coordinate research, study and survey on the status and usage of Dzongkha and other indigenous languages of Bhutan.
